Top seeds exit Singapore Youth Olympics

Top seeds Marton Fucsovics (HUN) and Elena Svitolina (UKR) have both suffered early defeats at the Youth Olympic Tennis Event in Singapore. The event continues at the Kallang Tennis Centre until Saturday 21 August.

Fucsovics, this year's Wimbledon junior champion, lost his first round match to Oliver Golding (GBR) 75 63 on Sunday. Roland Garros winner Svitolina then lost in the second round on Monday, going down 62 63 to Daria Gavrilova (RUS).

Svitolina was among a flurry of early upsets in the girls singles, with No. 2 seed Monica Puig (PUR), No. 4 Sachie Ishizu (JPN) and No. 6 Veronica Cepede Royg (PAR) all losing in the first round, and No. 5 An-Sophie Mestach (BEL) suffering a second round defeat. Six of the eight boys' seeds have reached round two, with No. 8 Renzo Oliver (ARG) the only other casualty.

A spectacular opening ceremony was held on the world's largest floating stage at Marina Bay on 14 August. Over 3,600 athletes from 204 countries joined 7,000 young singers and dancers and more than 24,000 spectators from all over the world. Seven tennis athletes were given the honour of carrying the flag for their countries: An-Sophie Mestach (BEL), Damir Dzumhur (BIH), Tiago Fernandes (BRA), Roberto Quiroz (ECU), Yuki Bhambri (IND), Zarah Razafimahatrata (MAD) and Veronica Cepede Royg (PAR).

IOC President Jacques Rogge told the capacity crowd and a worldwide television audience: "Today we open a new chapter in the history of the Olympic movement. From this moment on, young people around the world have a chance to participate in a global forum that combines sport, education and culture."

From 15 August until the closing ceremony on the 26th, the Singapore Youth Olympics will include 184 events in 26 different sports. The Youth Olympic Tennis Event features athletes from 38 countries.

ITF President Francesco Ricci Bitti said: "We expect our junior players will find the Youth Olympic Games very enjoyable but also very challenging. Many of them will discover for the first time how emotional and rewarding it can be to play for your country and this experience will help them in their careers as they play Davis Cup, Fed Cup and future Olympic Games."

On Monday Ricci Bitti attended a memorial service for Juan Antonio Samaranch in Singapore with other members of the Olympic family.

Part of the extended mission of the Youth Olympic Games is a cultural programme for the athletes. Ai Sugiyama will represent tennis as an athlete role model to interact not only with athletes from tennis but also the general athlete population.

The Youth Olympic Tennis Event finals will be held over two days, with the girls singles and boys doubles scheduled for Friday 20 August, and the boys singles and girls doubles for Saturday 21 August.
