PRESS RELEASE

The AITA Executive Committee will be meeting on 30th June 2018 following representations received from both former and current players and administrators to discuss proposals of ITF for amendment to the Davis Cup and Transition Tour.

The ITF has proposed changes in Davis Cup Competition by having a one-week World Group Finals of 18 Teams in November and certain changes have also been suggested in respect of Zonal ties and the Home and Away concept.

As regards Transition Tour, AITA has been informed that from 2020 there will be no ATP points for ITF Futures and points for players will only be available on the basis of ATP Challenger. In 2019 only the four Semi-Finalists will be awarded points for US\$ 25K Futures.

During the meeting, AITA will also be discussing the resolution proposed by AITA for changing the composition of the BOD of ITF. AITA has proposed a change in the composition to make the Board more representative of all the regions and nations and increasing the number of Directors from 13 to 14.

AITA will discuss this resolution keeping in view a meeting held during Roland Garros on 8th June 2018 between Mr David Haggerty, President ITF and Mr Bernard Giudicelli, Director ITF and President FFT with President AITA wherein AITA was requested to reconsider the submission of the proposal.
