On the occasion of Women's Day All India Tennis Association (AITA) and Maharashtra State Lawn Tennis Association (MSLTA) is organising an exclusive National Officiating School for Female Participants, under the auspices of International Tennis Federation on 9th and 10th March 2022 at MSLTA, Mumbai. This school will be exclusively only for Women who wish to pursue a career in tennis officiating.

The school will be open to female candidates from all over the country. Only 20 participants will be accepted into this school. The deadline will be Friday 25th February 2022. The list of selected candidates will be uploaded on AITA and MSLTA website on Monday 28th February 2022.

The two-day course will cover all aspects of officiating, including line umpiring and chair umpiring, with the primary aim of training officiating staff to ensure that they can work at national and international tournaments organised in India.

ITF Officiating Regional Officer - Asia/Oceania & Gold Badge Referee Mr. Nitin Kannamwar and ITF Gold Badge Referee Mrs. Sheetal Iyer, are the tutors for the course. ITF Officiating National Female Ambassador, Supriya Chatterjee will also be a part of the teaching team.
