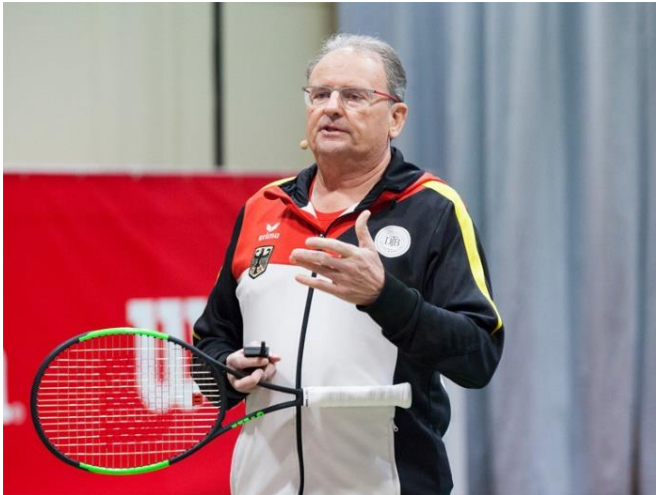
Name - Alexander Waske

- Former professional tennis player from Germany
- Turned pro in 2000
- In 2002 he made Grand Slam debut by qualifying at Wimbledon and reaching 2nd RD
- In 2004 made debut in Davis Cup for Germany
- **In 2005 helped Germany win the World Team Cup, Semifinalist at the Australian Open in doubles and quarter finals at Wimbledon in doubles**
- **In 2006 Semifinalist at the French Open in doubles**
- **He was ranked as high as World No. 16 in doubles, winning 4 titles (2006: Houston & Munich, 2007: Zagreb & Barcelona)**
- Career-high singles: No. 89 in June 2006
- **Biggest wins at the ATP tour:**
  - In 2002 beating No. 6 in the world Carlos Moya in Tokiyo**
  - In 2004 beating Goran Ivanisevic (Wimbledon Champion) in**

**Munich**

**In 2005 beating Rafael Nadal in Halle**

- Retired from the professional tour in 2012
- In 2010 Alexander Waske founded the Schüttler Waske Tennis-University, a tennis academy for professional tennis players. Since 2017 it is Alexander Waske Tennis-University GmbH.

- As a coach, mentor, tutor, speaker and moderator, Hans-Peter Born was responsible for the Coaches Education Program in Germany for more than 26 years. During this time, the DTB Coaches Education Program was well known as of one the best internationally.
- **During his time as a National Head Coach he coached players such as Angelique Kerber, Sabine Lisicki, Andrea Petkovic, Alexander Zverev, Rudi Molleker and Nicolas Kuhn and a lot of other successful players.**
- 1992 – 2019 National Head Coach and Director of Education of the German Tennis Federation
- 1983 – 1992 Head Coach of the Federation of the German State of Württemberg in Germany
- As a coach and captain, he was successful with his players and teams at European Championships, European Cups and World Junior Cups: 2x Winner World Junior Cup, 1x Runner Up World Junior Cup.
- Hans-Peter Born was and still serves as a speaker at national and international seminars and conferences
- He is author of a lot of well-known published articles
- He was the leader of the new German e-learning project, DTB Online Campus
- He was the leader of the project „International DTB Tenniskongress“
- He earned a degree in Sports Science at the German Sport University in Cologne
- He earned a diploma from the Coaches Academy (Trainerakademie) in Cologne
- He earned the highest Coaches Degree of the German Tennis Federation (A License) as well as the coaches degree from the Technical University Munich.
- In 2006 and in 2018 he received the awards of the DTB Coach of the year and in 2011 the Tennis Europe award for coaches.
